## Construction Update

December 2010

The Peninsula Link clearing and fencing programs are almost complete and bulk earthworks are now underway. These earthworks involve moving approximately three million cubic metres of soil around the project corridor. Haul roads are being constructed along the freeway alignment to move this soil and to keep most of the project's heavy vehicle traffic off local roads.

The number of truck movements will vary according to the construction program and a fleet of road sweepers will be out in force to keep local roads clean.

This summer, construction of the bridges and overpasses on roads intersecting Peninsula Link will get into full swing with works scheduled to commence at a number of locations. Scheduling bridgeworks in the first half of the project program means disruptions to traffic on local roads will be minimised later on. It also means the project team with unimpeded access to construct the freeway over or under local roads.

### Upcoming work

#### Skye Road

Traffic lights are being installed on Skye Road to assist truck movements across the local road.

#### Cranbourne Road

Construction of the haul road tunnel and Cranbourne Road side track are almost complete. Traffic is expected to be switched to the new side track in January.

#### The Pines

Earthworks are now underway in this section of the project. Top soil stripping is almost complete and work is set to commence on the Tamarisk Creek waterway crossing.

#### Stony Point Rail Bridge

Work will commence on the foundations for the Stony Point rail bridge in January, with the first beams due to arrive in late February.

#### Robinsons Road

Robinsons Road is now closed to traffic to allow for construction of the Robinsons Road bridge. Excavation is now underway with piling scheduled to start in January.

#### Baxter

Drainage works, top soil stripping and earthworks are scheduled for December in preparation for bridge works in early January.

#### Bungower Road

Work has commenced on side track construction on the north side of Bungower Road. The side track will allow unimpeded vehicle access around the bridge construction site. Traffic lights are being installed to allow trucks to cross Bungower Road safely.

#### Eramosa Road West

Traffic lights are being installed on Eramosa Road West to assist with truck movements.



Sediment ponds have been constructed at locations along the alignment.

### Mornington-Tyabb Road

Work has commenced on side track construction on the north side of Mornington-Tyabb Road. The side track means traffic will be able to move around the bridge construction site without using a local road.

### Derril Road

The Derril Road underpass is nearing completion. The road is expected to re-open in January. The new underpass structure will allow traffic to continue to use Derril Road while Peninsula Link is constructed over the top.
